Post Election – Preferred Coalition Opinion Poll

February 2020





Methodology and Weighting

- / RED C interviewed a random sample of 3700 adults aged 18+ online between Wednesday 12th and Friday 14th February.
- / A online approach was used, among our bespoke online panel, RED C Live, which consists of over 40,000 panellists recruited both online and face to face across Ireland.
- / Interviews are conducted across the country and the results weighted to the profile of all adults.
- / Panellists were chosen at random to complete the poll, with quotas set and weights allocated on age, gender, class and region to ensure a nationally representative sample.
- / A further past vote weighting is included that weights to first preference votes stated support for parties among panellists to the actual results of General Election 2020.
- / In all respects the poll was completed to the opinion polling guidelines set out by both ESOMAR and AIMRO.

Q. A coalition of parties will be required to form a government after this election. Can you tell us which of the following possible coalitions you think will be best for Ireland?




Sinn Féin leading a coalition with a combination of other parties such as Greens, Labour, Social Democrats, Independents and others
